## INTRODUCTION


Thank you for purchasing the Pinescript Trading Indicator Pool.

## SETTING UP YOUR INDICATOR

1. Open [www.TradingView.com](http://www.TradingView.com)
2. Select the “Pine Editor” tab at the bottom left of your screen.

## 3. Highlight all of the default code contained within the Pine Editor.

## 4. Delete all of the code from the Pine Editor.

5. Locate the indicator code you purchased and received within your email.
6. Copy and Paste the all of the code into the empty Pine Editor.
7. Select the **"Add to Chart"** tab. (The indicator will not overlay your chart until this step)

8. Select the “Save As...” tab and type the title given to the respective indicator within your e-mail.
